Covid-19 Mandate for the community of Kobuk, Alaska

1. A) All travel for the village of Kobuk, until August 15, 2020. No inter-village Travel.
B) Travel is permitted for cancer patients or with serious medical conditions only. Upon return to the village, self-quarantine for a minimum of 10 days. This includes ALL HOUSEHOLD members.
C) Stores or Business must close for 10 days if on quarantine for the safety of the community.
D) It is mandated that you take the test @ Alaska Airlines or Bering Air prior to traveling into Kobuk.
2. Tribal Office and City of Kobuk: places of business. Staff will be here, however would like to limit access to the public as much as possible. We ask that you call in to purchase gas or stove oil. The door will be locked 9am-noon. We will sell gas/stove oil 1pm-5pm.
3. A) The clinic is open 8am-5pm. Must call in for all appointments, prior to going there. Even if it is to pick up your medication.
B) No walk ins...
4. A) Restricted Non-resident visitors, including family. Effective until August. 15, 2020.
B) Enrolled tribal members will be allowed upon approval.
