STATEMENT ON REGULATION OF GAME MANAGEMENT AND HUNTING

Hunting seasons on state and private lands are regulated exclusively by the Alaska Board of Game (BoG). The Department of Fish and Game implements the BoG's regulations by issuing hunting licenses and permits. State of Alaska residents and non-Alaska-residents may hunt on state and private land (subject to landowner permission) whenever a season is open according to Board regulations. Boroughs and cities have no authority to close hunting seasons or regulate hunting on state and private lands in a way that conflicts with BoG regulations. The hunting seasons may only be closed by emergency regulations adopted by the BoG.

Hunting seasons on certain federal lands are regulated by the Federal Subsistence Board (FSB). Whenever the FSB determines that a non-rural Alaska community has customarily and traditionally hunted wildlife for subsistence, the FSB's regulations provide a priority for federally-qualified resident hunters on federal lands near that community. <u>Boroughs, cities, and the State have no authority to close hunting seasons that are open according to FSB regulations</u>. Additionally, the FSB has no authority to close federal lands to the public, including non-federally qualified users.

Our resources are important to all. Lands within the Northwest Arctic Borough are diverse in nature and fall under different management regulations. Landowners include state, federal, and private entities with differing rules and mandates. All hunters coming into the Borough boundaries must follow local emergency health mandates and show respect when arriving.
