

**NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY  
RESOLUTION 15-18**

**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH TOK WELDING AND FABRICATION FOR WASTE BURN UNITS, AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS:** the Borough received a Coastal Impact Assistance Program (CIAP) Grant for Improving Region-Wide Waste Management; and

**WHEREAS:** using waste burn units in Borough villages will help decrease the volume of solid waste in the community and environment, and contribute to more effective waste-management practices; and

**WHEREAS:** the Tok Welding portable trailer-mounted waste burn units are desirable for communities without access to heavy equipment; and


**WHEREAS:** the Borough will work with Tok Welding and shippers to determine the most economical shipping method to transport the waste burn units to villages; and

**WHEREAS:** the Borough wishes to use CIAP Grant funding to purchase and ship five waste burn units for five Borough communities.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly that:

- (1) the Mayor is authorized to negotiate and execute a Professional Services Agreement with Tok Welding and Fabrication in substantially the same form as accompanies this resolution; and
- (2) Total compensation for Tok Welding and Fabrication and for related shippers shall not exceed a total amount of \$207,500.


