**A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC  
BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING FUNDS FOR SEARCH AND  
RESCUE AND AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF BUILDING  
SUPPLIES, AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS:** Arctic Circle Search & Rescue (ACSAR) is organized as a nonprofit corporation operated exclusively for the promotion of public health and safety in Northwest Alaska; and

**WHEREAS:** ACSAR was formed to unify search and rescue volunteers in Kotzebue, to provide continual search and rescue capability, and to deliver administrative structure for search and rescue personnel; and

**WHEREAS:** ACSAR is currently without any facilities and wishes to utilize contributions from NANA, Shell, NAB, and others to purchase two 20'x28' prefabricated cabin kits to serve as an incident command center and a shop/storage facility; and

**WHEREAS:** the Borough's purchase of these two cabin kits will provide ACSAR significant cost savings; and

**WHEREAS:** the City of Kotzebue has agreed to offer ACSAR a long-term ground lease to place the two ACSAR structures.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly hereby accepts ACSAR funds in the amount of \$77,000 and authorizes the purchase of two building kits for ACSAR in an amount not to exceed \$115,000.
