### NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ORDINANCE 22-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING AND ADOPTING AN AMENDED LINE-ITEM BUDGET FOR SULIANICH ASSOCIATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022.

**WHEREAS:** under Ordinance 21-05, the Borough established its FY22 budget; and

WHEREAS: under Ordinance 21-05, the Borough included appropriations for Sulianich Association as a whole; and

WHEREAS: in order to establish separate funding mechanisms that include both general fund appropriations and use of Sulianich Association funds, the Borough wishes to establish separate budget approval for Sulianich Association.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED** by the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly as follows:

**Section 1.** CLASSIFICATION.

This is a non-code ordinance.

# Section 2. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

The budget document attached to this Ordinance provides for changes to the authorized revenues and expenditures and the changes in cash balances as part of the line item budget for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 for Sulianich Association and made a matter of public record.

Section 3. AUTHORIZATIONS AND APPROPRIATIONS.

The amended appropriation of \$360,967 is hereby adopted and authorized for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 and is the budget for that period. Subject to Assembly approval, by resolution, the Mayor may: (1) establish line item expenditures within an authorized appropriation, or (2) transfer

from one authorized appropriation to another any amount which would not annually exceed 10 percent or \$25,000, whichever is greater. Under no circumstances may the total amount of such transactions exceed \$150,000 prior to Assembly reappropriation pursuant to Section 2.08.020(E) of the Borough Code.

**Section 4.** This ordinance will be effective upon enactment.

Sulianich Arts Center Revenue:

Art Sales is budgeted at \$210,000. This is derived from the average sales over the past four years and adjusting a bit higher with the new sales approach.

Transfer from General Fund is budgeted at \$151,505. Historically, Sulianich has been able to keep the doors open through the contribution from the General Fund. The Economic Development Department would like to phase out of reliance on the General Fund. Currently, the General Fund subsidy (donation) covers the cost of <u>one employee</u>, supplies and utilities as outlined below.

**Sulianich Arts Center Expenditures:** 

**Salaries** is budgeted at \$141,944. The cost covers two employees, as outlined below. Please note that one of the employees is subsidized by the General Fund contribution. The newest employee would be employed by Sulianich and the art sales would cover 100% of the cost of the employee.

Sulianich Arts Center Expenditures continued:

**FICA** is budgeted at \$5,778. This covers the employer cost of social security (for the new employee) and medicare for both employees.

Unemployment Insurance is budgeted at \$3,026. This helps to build a reserve for unemployment claims.

**Medical** is budgeted at \$46,692. This cost is to cover medical insurance for the employee subsidized by the Borough General Fund. The new employee is being hired out of Sulianich and will not qualify for medical insurance.

**PERS** is budgeted at \$18,028. This covers the employer cost of retirement contributions for one employee. The new employee will participate in social security benefits, not PERS.

**Supplies** is budgeted at \$4,500. The budget covers miscellaneous office and craft supplies as identified. Please note NAB subsidizes \$3,500 of this cost.

**Utilities** is budgeted at \$21,000. The budget covers utility cost for the Sulianich Arts Center building, Please note NAB subsidizes 100% of this cost up to \$21,000.

**Art Purchases** is budgeted at \$120,000. The cost covers purchase of art from local artists for resale in the Sulianich Arts Center gallery.
