## NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ORDINANCE 23-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE FOR THE FRANK R. FERGUSON SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM, AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

WHEREAS: Chapter 2.60 of the Borough Code establishes the Frank R. Ferguson Memorial Scholarship Program and outlines its guidelines and implementation; and

WHEREAS: in order to more effectively administer the Scholarship Program, the Borough wishes to update the Borough Code to modify the scholarship award criteria; and

WHEREAS: the Northwest Arctic Borough Mayor and Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly wish to update the Borough Code as recommended by the Scholarship Committee to clarify its discretion and procedures as it administers the scholarship program.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED:** by the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly as follows:

**Section 1:** Chapter 2.60.020 of the Borough Code is amended as follows with additions indicated by **underlining** in bold and deletions by **strikethrough** in bold:

## Chapter 2.60

## FRANK R. FERGUSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

## 2.60.20 Scholarship awards.

A. For accredited academic schools: <u>Awards will be made according to the following schedule:</u>

<b>Enrolled Credits</b>	Maximum Award \$250			
1-2				
<u>3-5</u>	\$500			
6-8	\$1000			
9-11	\$1500			
12+	\$2000			

No individual award may exceed \$2,000 per semester or exceed \$1,500 per quarter for full-time students; nor exceed \$700.00 per semester or \$400.00 per quarter for part-time students.

- B. For vocational or technical schools: No individual award may exceed \$1,000 per training session under two months in length nor exceed \$2,000 per training session over two months in length.
- C. The awards of the committee shall be reported to the assembly.
- D. In conjunction with the requirements of this chapter the committee may take into consideration financial need, outstanding performance and community service in making its awards.
