NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 22-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE UNINCORPORATED COMMUNITY OF NOATAK FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE FY23 COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS: AS 29.60.865 and 3 AAC 180.070 require the assembly of a borough or unified municipality to adopt a resolution identifying those unincorporated communities located within their municipal boundaries that the assembly determines meet the Community Assistance Program (often referred to as Revenue Sharing) eligibility criteria established under AS 29.60.865, AS 29.60.879, and 3 AAC 180.110; and

WHEREAS: as an unincorporated community, Noatak has more than 25 residents and either a Native village council or incorporated nonprofit entity that will agree to receive and spend the Community Assistance payment for the public benefit of the unincorporated community; and

WHEREAS: the Native Village of Noatak meets this criteria and provides at least three of the following services, which are generally available to all residents of the community: fire protection, emergency medical, water and sewer, solid waste management, public road or ice road maintenance, public health, and search and rescue.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly hereby certifies that the Native Village of Noatak is eligible for funding under the FY23 Community Assistance Program.
