

**NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 13-11**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH
ACCEPTING STATE OPERATING FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$196,500.00 FOR THE VILLAGE PUBLIC SAFETY
OFFICER'S PROGRAM AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS: The Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly is the governing body for the Northwest Arctic Borough, an Alaska home rule, regional, municipal government that encompasses eleven communities within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS: The State of Alaska provides public safety services to rural areas of the state, in part, through the Village Public Safety Officer's Program; and

WHEREAS: The Borough has entered into an agreement with the State of Alaska to administer the Village Public Safety Officer's Program in our area; and

WHEREAS: The Village Public Safety Officer's program provides vital life, health and safety services to our residents; and

WHEREAS: The State of Alaska has agreed to provide an additional \$115,000.00 in funding for the program; and

WHEREAS: The funding will be used to repair and upgrade Village Public Safety Officer housing and office space in Noorvik, Shungnak, Noatak and Kiana, and to purchase a vehicle for Kotzebue; and


WHEREAS: The Borough desires to accept the additional funding from the State of Alaska for the program; and

WHEREAS: There is no matching requirement to receive these funds; and

WHEREAS: The NAB §6.16.210 requires the assembly approve any purchase over \$10,000.00 by resolution before the funds can be spent or reimbursed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Northwest Arctic Borough accepts the funds from the State of Alaska in an amount not to exceed \$196,500.00 for the Village Public Safety Officer's Program and authorizes the Mayor to execute any and all necessary documents required for acquisition and management of these funds.
