**A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY
APPROVING A COASTAL IMPACT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (CIAP)
SUBGRANT AWARD TO MANILAQ TO IMPROVE REGION-WIDE WASTE
MANAGEMENT AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES**

WHEREAS: the Borough received a multi-year Coastal Impact Assistant Program (CIAP) grant for coastal area conservation, protection, and restoration projects; and

WHEREAS: in accordance with federal CIAP guidelines, and consistent with CIAP authorized uses, the Borough prepared and submitted a CIAP grant application based on reducing, reusing and recycling waste materials to help protect, conserve and restore coastal areas; assistance in backhaul/recycling efforts to better manage and/or remove solid waste from the villages; and

WHEREAS: this grant will provide assistance in the recycling, backhaul and/or proper disposal of waste such as electronic waste, household toxic materials, recyclable metals and materials, white goods, and other recyclable materials; and

WHEREAS: under Section 6.16.410(A)(6) of the Northwest Arctic Borough Code, the Borough may procure professional or specialized services by sole source proposal; and


WHEREAS: Maniilaq Association through its Tribal Environmental Program has the resources and specialized expertise to offer backhaul and recycling waste management assistance in an affordable and effective manner; and

WHEREAS: the Borough wishes to enter into a subgrant agreement with Maniilaq Association for the amount not to exceed \$18,640.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly, for and on behalf of the Northwest Arctic Borough:


1. The Mayor is authorized to negotiate and execute a subgrant agreement with Maniilaq Association in substantially the same form as accompanies this resolution.
2. The compensation paid under the subgrant agreement is not to exceed \$18,640.00 subject to future CIAP grant appropriations as described in the contract and change order as permitted under Section 6.16.220 of the Borough Procurement Code.
3. This resolution shall be effective upon enactment.
