SECTION II – INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

Surplus Property Offered for Sale by Public Sealed Bid: The Northwest Arctic Borough is offering for sale a Blue 2012 4WD Ford Explorer, with mileage of 33,733; VIN: 1FM5K8B88DGA33662. The surplus property is offered for sale in “AS IS, WHERE IS, AND WITH ALL FAULTS” condition. It is the responsibility of each bidder to inspect and examine the condition of the property. The provided descriptions of the property are to be used for identification purposes only and are not to be considered a warranty of any kind. The Borough provides no warranties, representations, or guarantees regarding the condition or suitability of the property, implied or otherwise, and none attach to the property or sale.

Bid Format: Bid must be submitted on the form provided in Section III. No oral, telephone, or facsimile bids will be accepted. See Bid Submission below.

Signature on Bid: All bids must be signed. A signature on a bid certifies that the bid is made without collusion with any person, firm, or corporation making a bid for the same goods and is in all respects fair and without collusion or fraud. A signature on a bid also certifies that the bidder has read and fully understands all bid specifications, terms, and conditions.

Bid Submission: Hard copy sealed bids must be received and time-stamped by the Borough Clerk prior to bid closing time at 9 a.m., local time on August 19, 2019. No bid received after bid closing time will be considered. To ensure proper identification and handling, all bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly labeled “Surplus Property Public Sealed Bid FY20-01.” The Borough Clerk will not be responsible for the proper identification and handling of any bid not submitted in an envelope bearing the required label.

Bid Modification: Modifications or deletions made before submitting a bid must be initialed in ink by the person signing the bid. Bids, once submitted, may be modified in writing before the time and date set for bid closing. Any modifications shall be signed and state that the new document supersedes or modifies the prior bid. Modifications must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked “Bid Modification,” and identify the bid number and closing date.

Bid Withdrawals: Bids may be withdrawn in writing received by the Borough Clerk prior to bid closing time. Bids may also be withdrawn in person before bid closing time upon presentation of appropriate identification.

Bid Opening: Bids will be opened at 10 a.m. on August 19, 2019, in the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly Chambers, 163 Lagoon Street, Kotzebue, Alaska 99752. Bidders may be present; however, sale decisions will not be made at the opening.

Bid Evaluation: The highest bidder, in the discretion of the Borough, will be the successful bidder. The final acceptance of the bid is not binding upon the Borough until the successful bidder is notified, the Borough receives full payment for the property, and the Borough executes a final Bill of Sale.

Tie Bids: If two or more bidders offer the same price, the Borough may break the tie with the flip of a coin.

Minimum Bid: The minimum amount the Borough will accept is \$6,000.00.

Bid Rejection: The Borough reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

Payment: Once the successful bidder receives notification of the acceptance of its bid, the bidder has 10 business days to submit full payment to the Borough. Payment may be made in cash, by bank draft, or cashier's check. Personal checks will not be accepted. Payment must be received before the Borough will transfer the property to the successful bidder. The successful bidder is responsible for the payment of all costs associated with the purchase and conveyance of the property, including transfer costs and fees.

Bid Results: Only a successful bidder will be notified of bid results; unsuccessful bidders will not be notified. Bid files are public records and available for review at the Borough Clerk's office between 9 - 11 a.m. and 2 - 4 p.m. Monday through Friday.
