RESOLUTION 21-44**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTHWEST  
ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING  
A VILLAGE IMPROVEMENT FUND  
APPLICATION FROM THE CITY OF AMBLER  
FOR PHASES 2 & 3 OF A GRAVEL  
EXTRACTION AND STOCKPILING PROJECT,  
AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS:** under Section 11.08.010 of the Borough Code, the Borough Village Improvement Commission was established to identify village service and capital improvement needs, plan and implement capital improvement and public service programs, and oversee investment of the Borough's Village Improvement Fund (VIF); and

**WHEREAS:** under Section 11.08.020 of the Borough Code, the Commission is responsible for advising the Borough Administration with respect to working with village residents, Borough communities, and village utilities to identify projects and programs for recommended funding; and

**WHEREAS:** on August 10, 2021, the Village Improvement Commission passed Commission Resolution 21-10, approving the City of Ambler's application in the amount of \$514,597 for Phases 2 & 3 of a gravel extraction project to manage a gravel mining operation and to stockpile gravel for community projects, and recommending the application for final approval by the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly; and

**WHEREAS:** in July 2020, the Borough approved the City of Ambler's VIF application in the amount of \$130,000 for Phase 1 of a gravel extraction and stockpiling project to supply gravel for community projects; and

**WHEREAS:** Ambler has an ongoing need for gravel required for a number of community projects; and

**WHEREAS:** the project will create local jobs for extraction and stockpiling while providing gravel necessary for NIHA housing units, an ANTHC/ARUC water/sewer project, an ANTHC biomass project, and other dedicated community projects; and


**WHEREAS:** the gravel extracted and stockpiled under this project will be dedicated for community use, not resale for profit; and

**WHEREAS:** the proposed use of funds meets the VIF eligibility requirements and will benefit the community; and

**WHEREAS:** the Assembly wishes to approve the VIF application.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:** the City of Ambler's VIF application in the amount of \$514,597 for Phases 2 & 3 of a gravel extraction and stocking project to manage a gravel mining operation and to stockpile gravel for community projects is approved.
