

**NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY
RESOLUTION 18-30**

A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TRANSFERRING A HYDROPONICS VAN TO THE CHUKCHI CAMPUS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA FAIRBANKS.

WHEREAS: the Borough owns a hydroponics van valued at approximately \$118,000 located in Kotzebue; and

WHEREAS: the Borough is not using and has not used the hydroponics van for some time; and

WHEREAS: Section 2.56.010(D) of the Borough Code allows the Assembly to dispose of surplus tangible personal property valued at more than \$25,000 by resolution to “an educational, charitable, or nonprofit association or corporation providing service to residents of the borough” under subsection (D); and

WHEREAS: the Chukchi Campus of the University of Alaska Fairbanks (“Chukchi Campus”) is located in Kotzebue and provides services to the residents of the Borough; and

WHEREAS: the Chukchi Campus wishes to acquire title to the hydroponics van for use in a nonprofit food security program for the community of Kotzebue to grow fresh local food year-round; and

WHEREAS: the Chukchi Campus may also use the hydroponics van as a hands-on environmental education tool to learn about plants, our environment, renewable energy, and other STEM-related activity; and

WHEREAS: the Assembly has determined that it is in the Borough’s best interest to transfer title of the hydroponics van to the Chukchi Campus for use in a nonprofit food security program for the community of Kotzebue to grow fresh, local food year-round and as a hands-on environmental education tool to learn about plants, our environment, renewable energy, and other STEM-related activity.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly approves the transfer of title of the hydroponics van to the Chukchi Campus; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: the Mayor is hereby authorized to take such action and execute such documents necessary to transfer title of the hydroponics van to the Chukchi Campus.


