RESOLUTION 19-24**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE
NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH
ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZING TRANSFER
OF FUNDS WITHIN THE ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT FOR
SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS, AND FOR
RELATED PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS: the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly is the governing body of the Northwest Arctic Borough; and

WHEREAS: Chapter 2.60 of the Borough Code established the Frank R. Ferguson Scholarship Program to award scholarships for education and training; and

WHEREAS: under Borough Code Section 6.12.060(E), subject to Assembly approval by resolution, the Mayor may: (1) establish line item expenditures within an authorized appropriation, or (2) transfer from one authorized appropriation to another any amount which would not annually exceed 10 percent or \$25,000, whichever is greater; and

WHEREAS: the Economic Development Department has requested transfer of \$40,000 within Economic Development Department to award scholarships under the FR Ferguson Scholarship Program; and


WHEREAS: the proposed transfers to FR Ferguson Scholarships are as follows:

- \$5,000 – Printing & Publications
- \$7,900 – Dues & Subscriptions
- \$5,000 – Training
- \$9,000 – Consultants
- \$13,000 – Small Business Grants

WHEREAS: if transferred, these funds will provide additional scholarship awards for the FR Ferguson Scholarship Program.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly approves the Borough's transfer of \$40,000 within the Economic Development Department to fund scholarship awards under the Frank R. Ferguson Scholarship Program.
