
PUBLIC NOTICE

09/20/2021

In order to prevent and make the necessary precautions amidst the latest developments with COVID-19, the governing bodies have made the decision to take these steps:


1. ALL TRAVEL IS RESTRICTED TO CANCER AND HEART MEDICAL AND ESSENTIAL WORK ONLY.
2. ALL TRAVELERS MUST HAVE PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE TRIBE/CITY BEFORE ENTERING THE VILLAGE.
3. ALL TRAVELERS ENTERING SELAWIK MUST SHOW A NEGATIVE COVID TEST PRIOR TO ENTERING THE VILLAGE (TESTING IN KOTZEBUE, WITHIN 48 HRS)
4. Those who present proof of having received both vaccine shots upon arrival are **REQUIRED TO QUARANTINE FOR THREE (3) DAYS**. If travelers are not vaccinated then they must quarantine for five days, and test on the 5th day. If there is a positive case in the household, ALL members of the household must quarantine for 10 days. If residents are not following the mandate of quarantining, there will be fines implemented, they are as follows:
 1. 1st infraction: \$300.00
 2. 2nd infraction: 450.00
 3. 3rd infraction: 600.00
5. A curfew is in place, 10:00 pm for EVERYONE!
6. Inter-village travel is prohibited.
7. Masks **MUST** be worn at all times when in public areas by ALL. Public areas include: School, Stores, Clinic, Tribal and City offices, and the Post office.) Once inside social distancing guidelines must be followed.
8. The Fuel Project and Rotmans Stores will also take the necessary precautions; staff personal hygiene is mandated to protect both staff and customers. No more than 5 customers at a time, at the Fuel Project and 10 at Rotmans Stores.
9. Lockdown will be initiated if deemed necessary by village leadership.
10. These mandates will be effective on the date of signature and until further notice.

We are looking out for the health, safety, and well-being of our community. We would like to be proactive, rather than reactive. This mandate will be used as a tool to minimize the spread of the virus. Any questions or concerns you have, please feel free to contact the City or Tribal Office Administrators at their respective offices. **We strongly encourage our residents to get vaccinated.** We can work together and be responsible to address the need for action in the best interest of our community.
