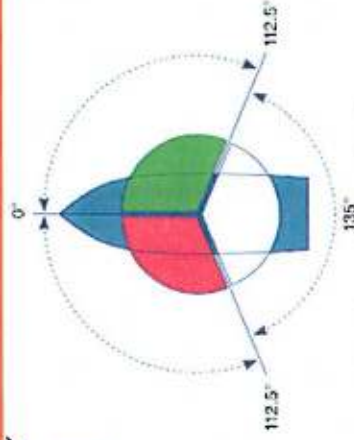
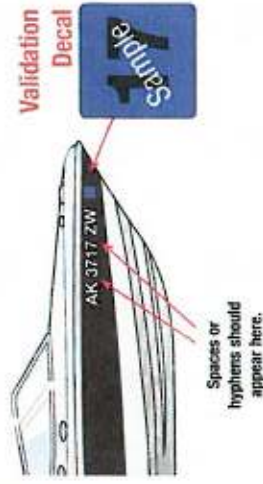


KOTZEBUE SOUND COMMERCIAL FISHING VESSEL CHECKLIST

FOR SALMON SKIFFS <26 FT WITHIN 3 NM FROM SHORE WITH 3 OR LESS PEOPLE ABOARD



REPORT ALL INJURIES

UNITED STATES LAW, 46 UNITED STATES CODE 30603, REQUIRES EACH SEAMAN ON A FISHING VESSEL, FISH PROCESSING VESSEL, OR FISH TENDER VESSEL TO NOTIFY THE MASTER OR INDIVIDUAL IN CHARGE OF THE VESSEL OR TO THEIR AGENT OF THE EMPLOYER REGARDING ANY ILLNESS, DISABILITY, OR INJURY SUFFERED BY THE SEAMAN WHEN IN SERVICE TO THE VESSEL NOT LATER THAN SEVEN DAYS AFTER THE DATE ON WHICH THE ILLNESS, DISABILITY, OR INJURY AROSE.
