

**NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE 14-01 am 01**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC  
BOROUGH ASSEMBLY PROVIDING FOR THE  
ESTABLISHMENT AND ADOPTION OF THE LINE  
ITEM BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR THE FISCAL  
YEAR 2015.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC  
BOROUGH:

Section 1.     **CLASSIFICATION**  
                  This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2.     **GENERAL PROVISIONS.**

                  The budget document attached provides for the authorized  
                  revenues and expenditures and the change in cash balances as part of  
                  the budget for the period July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015, and  
                  made a matter of public record.

Section 3.     **AUTHORIZATION AND APPROPRIATIONS.**

                  The appropriations of \$14,627,406 is hereby adopted and authorized  
                  for the period July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015, and is the budget for  
                  that period. Subject to Assembly approval, by resolution, the Mayor  
                  may; (1) establish line item expenditures within an authorized  
                  appropriations to another any amount which would not annually  
                  exceed 10% or \$25,000 whichever is less. In no circumstances may  
                  the total of such transactions exceed \$150,000.00 prior to the Assembly  
                  re-appropriation process, pursuant to Section 2.08.020 (E) of the  
                  Borough Code.

Section 4.     **EDUCATION APPROPRIATIONS**

                  The appropriations of \$55,830,613.00 is approved and authorized as  
                  follows:
