A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING ALASKA STATE LEGISLATIVE CAPITAL GRANT FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015.

WHEREAS: The Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly is the governing body for the Northwest Arctic Borough, an Alaska home rule, regional, municipal government that encompasses eleven communities within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS: In previous years the Borough has requested state legislative grant funds from the Alaska State Legislature for capital projects in the Borough; and

WHEREAS: In prior years, the Alaska Legislature has appropriated legislative grant funds for some of the Borough's requested capital projects; and

WHEREAS: The Borough has utilized the state legislative grant funds to improve the lives of residents in the Borough; and

WHEREAS: For fiscal year 2015, the Borough has received funding for the following projects in the following amounts:

- 1. Borough-wide LED Light Project \$200,000.00
- 2. Borough-wide Search and Rescue Support \$185,000.00
- 3. Borough-Wide Maintenance and Repair of Heavy Equipment \$200,000.00
- 4. Residential Magnet Boarding School \$5.5 million
- 5. Kivalina Heavy Equipment \$400,000.00
- 6. Deering Library \$11,434.00
- 7. Kobuk House Repairs \$25,998.00

WHEREAS: All of these projects will benefit the residents of the Borough.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly accepts the Fiscal Year 2015 legislative capital grant funds as detailed in this resolution.
